

(All Kneeling) - Humble Access

Priest: Lord, in humility and hearts of appreciation, we do not take for granted this access you have given us. Transform our lives as we do this in obedience to your command and remembrance of the complete work of redemption done for us in the name of your son Jesus Christ. Amen

Priest: Draw near with faith, receive the Body of our Lord Jesus Christ which He gave you, and His Blood which He shed for you. Eat and drink in remembrance that He died for you, and feed on Him in your heart by faith with thanksgiving.

He'll make your wants His care.

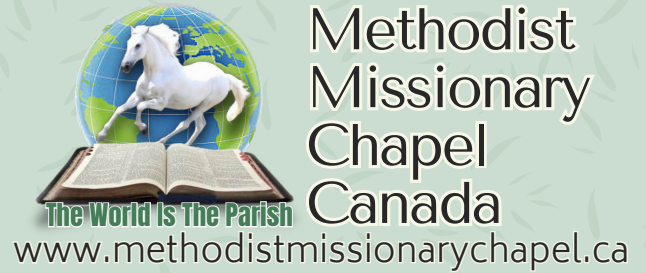
NICENE CREED
