

(All Kneeling) - Humble Access

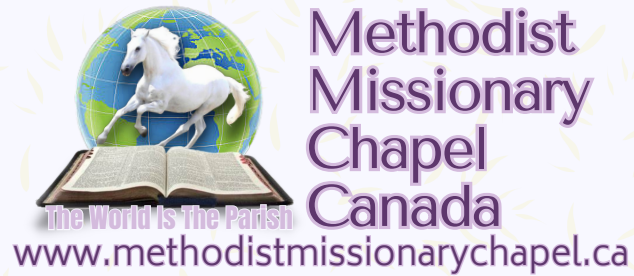
